- Candles & Incense & Anything with an Open Flame
- Hookahs
- Space Heaters
- Hot Plates (or anything with an open coil/burner or hot surface)
- Extension Cords (that are not surge protected)
- Firearms, Weapons, Explosives, Fireworks, Ammunition, Gasoline, Projectile Devices, Knives
- Harmless Instruments Designed to Look Like Firearms, Weapons, Explosives, etc.
- Electrical/Amplified Instruments & Drums (may not be practiced on the property)
- Cases of Bottled Water
- Incandescent or Halogen Light Bulbs
- Paper Towels
- Non-Energy Star® Appliances
- Octopus electrical outlets or extensions
